## CLUSIACEAE

## OMISSION OF HYPERICUM OLIGANDRUM FROM THE FLORA OF SOUTHERN AFRICA

In the revision of Hypericum by the author and N. K. B. Robson in Flora of Southern Africa 22: 14-20 (1976), a species up to that time only once recorded from South West Africa, H. oligandrum Milne-Redh. (originally described from the Lunga River near Mwinilunga in Zambia) was unfortunately omitted. Merxmüller & Giess 1975 from "the banks and islands of the Okavango, Andara" was cited in

Prodr. Fl. S.W. Afr. 44: 1 (1968), but a duplicate specimen only reached the National Herbarium (PRE) in 1977. Recently a second specimen, Giess 15230, was collected in May 1978 on the farm Otiihaenamaparero near Otjiwarango. This omission is regretted and thanks are due to Professor H. Merxmüller for drawing it to the author's attention.
